

## AP EXAM ORDERING

AP Exam registration starts next week. All exam registration and payment takes place at the home school, except for students from out of district who register and pay at Central Academy.

- Registration for AP exams **starts January 16** and **ends April 1**. Students order all tests on one order form.
- Each AP Exam costs \$91. Once a student turns in an order form, the fee will show up in Infinite Campus and can be paid online with a credit card or with a check or cash to the school bookkeeper. The fee can be paid in installments or all at once.
- There are funding supports.  
Any student who qualifies for **free or reduced priced lunch** will be able to take AP exams at **no cost**, for courses in which they are currently enrolled, thanks to a grant from the United Way of Central Iowa and financial waivers from the College Board.
- Student registration process:
  - Students pick up a registration form from the home school or CA main office (*\*locations vary check with your home school AP Site Coordinators– main office, counseling office, teachers*).
  - Students take the completed form and a deposit/payment to the school's bookkeeper.
  - The bookkeeper takes the form and deposit/payment and puts all of the information into Infinite Campus.
  - The bookkeeper will file the **WHITE copy** of the registration form and give the **YELLOW** copy to the student.

### TEST LOCATIONS:

Most AP Tests are given in the five comprehensive High schools (East, Hoover, Lincoln, North, Roosevelt) even if students take the AP class at Academy. However, if students do not attend one of these five schools, they order and take their exams at Academy.

Some exams are **ONLY** given at Academy. So, if students who attend one of the five comprehensive high schools take one of these exams, they will still order and pay for the exam at their home school, but they will take the exam at Academy. The following exams will be only given at Academy:

In addition, because these courses are not offered in these schools:

Students at East, Lincoln and North will take the AP Chemistry exam at Academy (order and pay at home school).

Students at Hoover will take Calculus AB and Macroeconomics exams at Academy (order and pay at Hoover).
