KEY LUNCH INFORMATION

High Schools:

Eat Lunch where you have block 3 or block 7.

7th Grade: Eat lunch at home school.

8th Grade: Eat lunch at Academy.

Your lunch code is your 6-digit student ID number. If you receive free or reduced lunch at DMPS school, it transfers to Central automatically. If you attend a community eligible school, your eligibility transfers with you to Central.

Students go through the lunch line at Campus (there are 5 -6 lines open) and can eat in the Campus cafeteria or bring a portable lunch over to Academy.



Students who attend Community College Schools and automatically receive free breakfast and lunch will have the same benefits at General.

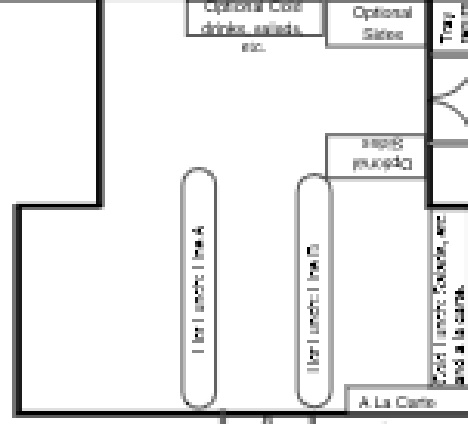
Students from East Lincoln, Rosemead, Bredley Center, General, a parent who fill out an application and qualify for free or reduced priced meals will also have the same benefits at General (no additional application required).

Use the same lunch number you have at your home school – same as last year.

Campus Lunch Map

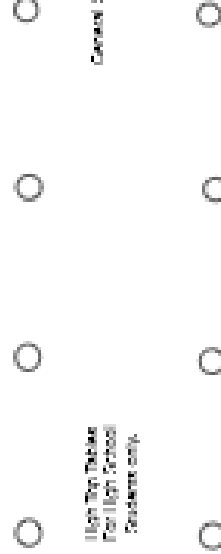
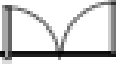
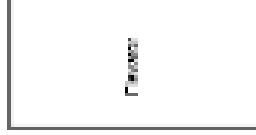


Library

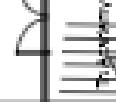

Be careful! Don't use drive way during passing times... too many buses.



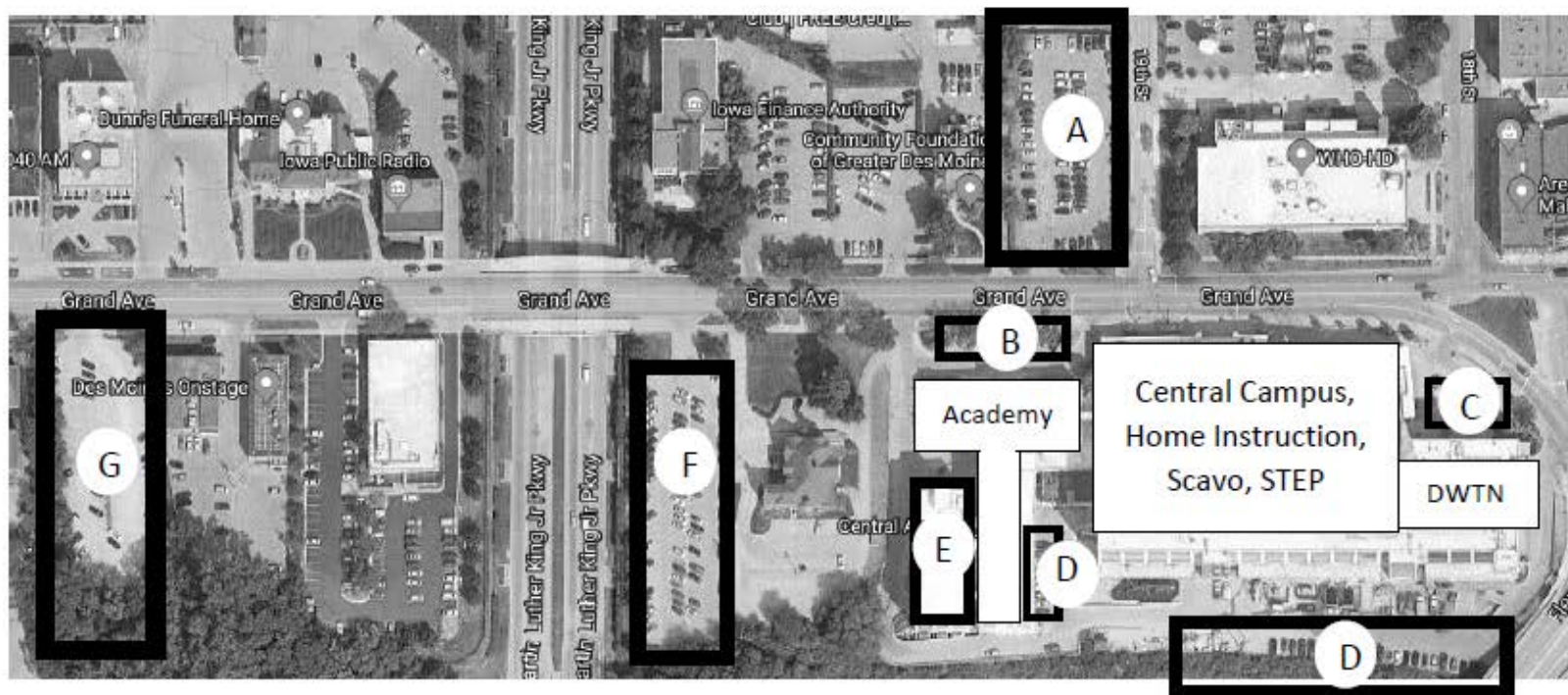
PARKING

Students who attend the Central Complex for more than half the school day are eligible for Parking Passes for West Lot 1. Out of District and Scavo students are eligible for the Reserved & Visitor Lot. Others may be considered on space available (unusual). Come to the Academy office or the Campus lobby to fill out an application for a parking pass in the first few weeks of school.

There is no parking on Grand Ave. or 19th Street. However, metered parking is on 18th street and free parking on Ingersoll and along the side streets north of Ingersoll. All the spaces in front of Academy are reserved for handicapped parking only.

Picking up students: Please encourage students to use the cross walk at 19th street when crossing Grand Ave. We don't want any injuries.

During bus passing times, the driveway in front of Academy is reserved for buses. Don't try to bring your car through at those times. Instead, choose a meeting spot (such as along 18th street) and have your student come to you. Meters are not enforced during after school pick up times. During class times, the visitor parking is available to pick up your student.



VISITOR SIGN IN



Parents:

Any visitors must be checked in and approved with an ID.

Your approval will be good for 90 days—just sign in with your 6 digit ID number (or we can sign you in if you don't remember it)

After 90-days, you'll have to present your ID again.

If you parked in visitor parking we'll ask you to sign in your car with make, model & plate number.

ENGLISH BOOK ORDERS:

You can now order Academy English novels on online.

If you go to <http://dmschools.org>

-> Parents (in the middle of the page)

-> Online Payments

you will be able to sign in with your Infinite Campus ID and child's birth date. If you have more than one child in English classes at Central Academy, you'll have to place an order for each of them.

To make the process easier this year, we've identified the books by grade level. For example, 9th grade books are identified as

"18-19 WH9TH...[name of book]".

(WH stands for "Wallace Homestead" the name of the Building where Academy is located).

Be sure you select all the books you'll need-- each class has several titles.

If you'd rather place your order after school starts, just drop off the order form in the office (order forms are available in the office and with English teachers)



If you already own some or all of these novels, you do not need to purchase them from us. Just keep in mind students will be asked to annotate the book. So, be sure it is okay for the student to write in the book.

Students who receive free or reduced priced lunch will also receive their novels for free or at half price. Just place the order in the office, with the English teacher, or visit <http://ca.dmschools.org> for the link and your account will be credited.
