

## Concurrent Enrollment Courses with DMACC Credit

In DMACC concurrent enrollment courses, students may decide to:

### OPTION 1: Withdraw from the course entirely (both high school and DMACC)

Student gets a "W" on their high school transcript	Student gets a "W" on their DMACC transcript	No	No	No impact on GPA

\*Student cannot withdraw from a course entirely if they are a senior and the course is required to meet graduation requirements.

### OPTION 2: Remain in the course for high school and DMACC credit

- Students remaining in the course for high school and DMACC credit may need to complete additional content to meet course requirements as determined by the instructor.
  - Your teacher will inform you of what additional content, if any, remains to be covered to complete the necessary DMACC course requirements.
  - If needed, extended time may be given to meet these requirements.

How does it impact high school transcript?	How does it impact DMACC transcript?	Does student earn high school credit?	Does student earn DMACC credit?	How does it impact GPA calculations?
Earned grade entered on high school transcript	Earned grade entered on DMACC transcript	Yes (if D or higher)	Yes (if C or higher) *	Earned grade factored into cumulative GPA

\*If earning a C or higher, students may elect to take the course as a Pass/No Pass for both their high school and DMACC transcripts. This would result the student earning high school and DMACC credit but remove the grade from their GPA calculations.

### OPTION 3: Take the course for high school credit only

- Students would take the course for high school credit and drop the DMACC portion of the course, earning a Pass/No Pass for the high school credit.
