Central Academy was established in 1985 to bring together students who demonstrate early readiness for advanced work to challenge them with an accelerated, compacted, and enriched curriculum. Beginning in seventh grade, students from the greater Des Moines area form a supportive community of motivated learners focused on inquiry and depth of knowledge and skills.

Mission

Central Academy provides additional services for students in comprehensive schools by offering the Accelerated Core Pathway and unique AP & World Language courses. Our Accelerated Core Pathway fosters academic excellence through the challenge of compacted curricula by offering acceleration and enrichment for students who demonstrate early readiness for advanced work. Students, especially those under-represented in gifted programs, develop competence, connection, and confidence as they embrace challenging coursework.

Advanced Placement Program:

Central Academy offers the Advanced Placement Capstone program in addition to a broad range of AP classes. Students have the option to take Advanced Placement courses both at Academy and at their comprehensive school. The Central Academy Advanced Placement courses are often accelerated and compacted versions if the courses are offered in both schools. Central Academy also offers courses that go beyond AP offerings for college credit. For example, students may take the History of the Middle East and Islam or Advanced Mathematical Problem Solving.

In the spring of 2024, 932 AP exams were given to students enrolled in AP courses at Academy with 67% earning a score of 3 or higher and 36% with a score of 4 or higher. High School enrollment was 1295 with 283 seniors in the class of 2024.
